School Assignments: There will be limited time allotted to work on school assignments. We ask that only the *necessary* homework be sent. Instruction on the ECC will be our focus!

The Snap Circuits Jr. Access Kit (exclusively from APH) teaches students about circuits, current, resistance, switches, motors and other electronics concepts. The brightly colored parts are labeled in braille, so they're accessible to students who are blind or have low vision.
