

Our short-term programs focus on teaching the Expanded Core Curriculum (ECC) which includes essential skills that students of all ages who are low vision or blind need to access their environment and live independently. It is the goal of NDVS/SB to assist individuals in pursuing their personal ambitions through assessment and training. Skills taught through the ECC equip students and adults to become confident and self-reliant.
